



# ALVAR AALTO MEETS JEAN SIBELIUS - A UNIQUE FINLANDIA HALL EXPERIENCE

Designed by **Alvar Aalto**, Finlandia Hall is one of Helsinki's most iconic landmarks and a masterpiece of Finnish architecture.

In this special Sibelius experience, the unique atmosphere of Finlandia Hall meets the timeless music of Finland's national composer **Jean Sibelius**.

The program begins at Finlandia Hall, with an approximately 20-minute concert. A concert pianist performs Sibelius's works *The Spruce*, *Intermezzo* from the *Karelia Suite*, and the symphonic poem *Finlandia*, known worldwide as a symbol of freedom. The music is introduced with short explanations and musical examples. A glass of Alvar sparkling wine and a Jean and Aino Music gift completes the experience.

After the concert, guests visit the **Finlandia Exhibition**, which tells the story of **Alvar, Aino and Elissa Aalto**, as well as Finnish identity and culture. The exhibition visit lasts approximately forty minutes.

After the tour, guests may enjoy lunch at **Finlandia Cafe & Wine** or a dinner-level dining experience at **Finlandia Bistro**.
